



White's Tree Frog (aka Dumpy)

Size: 3-4.5 inches long

Life Span: 7-10 years with proper care



Heat and Lighting:

- No lighting is *required*, but a daytime bulb to highlight the frogs can be used
- Avoid using heat lamps as they may dry out the frogs
- Ideal daytime temperature is 75-85, if kept in a cool room use a heat mat on the side

Tank setup:

- A 10-20 gallon (depending on number of frogs) **horizontal** terrarium should be provided as these frogs like to climb; provide vines, branches, and other decoration that they can climb
- Terrariums must have a well-ventilated lid
- Use substrate such as coconut fiber or other substrates that retain moisture well

Diet: Only Insectivores

- Staple foods include gut-loaded crickets and earthworms
- Treat foods include superworms or mealworms, waxworms, Dubia roaches, or hornworms
- Feed as many crickets as they will eat in 10-15 minutes, *adults* 2-3 times per week and *juveniles* every 1-2 days

Water and Humidity:

- Humidity should be maintained by regular misting with treated (with stress coat) water, with a goal humidity of 50%
- A large water bowl should be provided at all times and changed regularly to keep clean

Temperament & Handling:

- Naturally more active at night, but if you feed them during the day they will adjust
- Tolerate handling quite well, can even become accustomed to it
- Do not have “biting teeth” and if they latch on to your finger they won’t hurt you
- Be sure your hands are clean and soap and lotion-free before handling as their skin is delicate and permeable; wash your hands well after handling

Housemates: Multiple frogs can be kept together, but they should be about the same age and size as older (larger) ones may cannibalize younger (smaller) ones

Sexing: Females are much larger than males, with a wider and more stout head, males usually have a stretched-out looking throat
